



**DIRECTIONS TO
IFC CERTIFICATION LTD
20 PARK STREET, PRINCES RISBOROUGH, BUCKS., HP27 9AH**

PRINCES RISBOROUGH is situated approximately 35 miles north west of central London. It is on a main railway line (Chiltern Railways) between London Marylebone and Birmingham, and within 15 minutes drive of the M40 London to Birmingham motorway. The M25 London Orbital motorway is approximately 25 minutes driving time.

Access from London's Airports is gained via the M25 motorway. (see enclosed map).

Detailed directions to IFC's Offices are given, below.

Please note that visitors arriving by car are requested to park in the Church Street public car park

By train:

Princes Risborough station is served by Chiltern Railways services from LONDON MARYLEBONE to STRATFORD-UPON-AVON and BIRMINGHAM (Snow Hill and Moor Street). Marylebone station is on the Bakerloo line of the London Underground and is 5 minutes walk from Baker Street Underground station which is on the Metropolitan, Hammersmith & City, Circle, Jubilee, and Bakerloo lines.

From London: Take a *Chiltern Railways* Birmingham, Bicester North, Stratford-upon-Avon or Princes Risborough train from Marylebone to Princes Risborough. Fastest journey time is approximately 45 minutes and there are generally 3 or 4 trains per hour, depending on the time of day.

From the North: Some of *Chiltern Railways'* Birmingham to London trains call at Princes Risborough (travel south and change at Bicester North for a more frequent service). The Birmingham to Princes Risborough time is approximately 90 minutes). Trains call at Solihull (bus link to Birmingham Airport), Warwick Parkway, Warwick, Leamington Spa, Banbury, and Bicester.

Princes Risborough can be reached from the North and North West of England by using *Virgin Trains* services to Leamington Spa or Banbury and changing trains to *Chiltern Railways*.

From Heathrow Airport: Take the *Heathrow Express* to London Paddington. Take the *Bakerloo Line* to Marylebone.

Or, take the *Piccadilly Line* Underground to Piccadilly Circus, then the *Bakerloo Line* Underground to Marylebone.

From Marylebone take *Chiltern Railways* as described above.

Heathrow Express takes approximately 15 minutes to reach Central London.

The *Piccadilly Line* takes approximately 45 minutes to reach Central London.

From Gatwick Airport: Take the *Gatwick Express* or *Southern* services to London Victoria. Take the *Victoria Line* Underground to Oxford Circus, then the *Bakerloo Line* Underground to Marylebone. From Marylebone take *Chiltern Railways* as described above

Gatwick Express takes approximately 30 minutes to reach Central London.

From Stanstead Airport: Take the *Stanstead Express* to London Liverpool Street. Take the *Central Line* Underground to Oxford Circus, then the *Bakerloo Line* Underground to Marylebone. From Marylebone take *Chiltern Railways* as described above

Stanstead Express takes approximately 50 minutes to reach Central London.

By road:

Princes Risborough is situated on the A4010 trunk road between the M40 junction 4 at High Wycombe, and Aylesbury. Access is also available from Junction 6 and Junction 8A of the M40.

From London: Take the A40 and M40 to junction 4 at High Wycombe.

From junction 4 take the A4010 (*signposted Aylesbury*) through High Wycombe to its junction with the A40. Turn left on to the A40 and continue for approximately half a mile to a roundabout.

At the roundabout, turn right on to the A4010 (*signposted Princes Risborough, Aylesbury*).

Princes Risborough is approximately 6 miles.

From the North: Take the M40 south to junction 8A.

From junction 8A take the A418 (*signposted Thame, Aylesbury*) towards Thame.

After 4 miles turn left at the first roundabout. At the second roundabout go straight on to the A4129 (*signposted Princes Risborough*).

At the next roundabout turn left, Princes Risborough is approximately 6 miles.

From the West: Take the M4 to junction 8/9 at Maidenhead.

From junction 8/9 take the A404(M) and A404 to the junction with the M40 (junction 4) at High Wycombe.

From junction 4 take the A4010 (*signposted Aylesbury*) through High Wycombe to its junction with the A40.

Turn left on to the A40 and continue for approximately half a mile to a roundabout.

At the roundabout, turn right on to the A4010 (*signposted Princes Risborough, Aylesbury*).

Princes Risborough is approximately 6 miles.

From the M25 south, Heathrow and Gatwick Airports:

(From Heathrow Airport take the M4 to junction 4B and join the M25)

(From Gatwick Airport take the M23 to junction 8 and join the M25)

Take the M25 to junction 16 (M40).

From junction 16 take the M40 (*signposted Birmingham, Oxford*).

Take the M40 to junction 4 at High Wycombe.

From junction 4 take the A4010 (*signposted Aylesbury*) through High Wycombe to its junction with the A40.

Turn left on to the A40 and continue for approximately half a mile to a roundabout.

At the roundabout, turn right on to the A4010 (*signposted Princes Risborough and Aylesbury*).

Princes Risborough is 6 miles.

From the M25 north, Luton and Stanstead Airports:

(From Luton Airport take the M1 to junction 6A and join the M25)

(From Stanstead Airport take the M11 to junction 6 and join the M25)

Take the M25 to junction 20 (A41).

From junction 20 take the A41 (*signposted Aylesbury*) to the junction with the B4009 near Tring. 14 miles.

From the roundabout take the B4009 (*signposted Wendover*) for approximately one third of a mile to the first left-hand junction.

Turn left on to the B4009 (*signposted Wendover*) to Wendover. 3 miles.

In Wendover, turn left at mini-roundabout. Travel up High Street to next mini-roundabout.

Go straight on at mini-roundabout on to unclassified road (*signposted Princes Risborough*).

After approximately 3 miles turn left on to A4010 (*signposted Princes Risborough*).

Princes Risborough is approximately 2 miles

Directions to 20 Park Street or Church Street Car Park in Princes Risborough:

Park Street is a turning off of Bell Street, which is the A4010 High Wycombe to Aylesbury trunk road.

There is a Royal Mail building on the corner of Bell Street/Park Street and an 'Esso' petrol station opposite the road junction.

Number 20 is located within the buildings which are situated on the right at the bottom of Park Street.

IFC's headquarters are the furthest building from the road.

The **visitors Car Park in Church Street** is accessed via the High Street and Church Street (from south - 2nd left after Park Street) or via Duke Street and Church Street (from north – off Tesco roundabout).(See enclosed map).

Access from the visitors Car Park to IFC's Offices is by a pedestrian alleyway to the end of Park Street, immediately adjacent to our Offices. (*distance approx. 50m*)

If you stand with the church to your left you will notice a pedestrian exit straight in front of you. Go down the walkway and our offices are on the left. You will see a number of cars in our car park. IFC Offices are the last office on the right.
